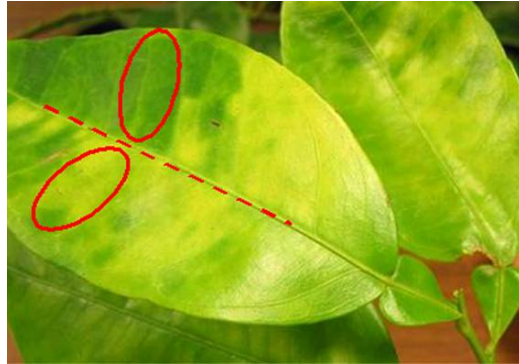


Not found in California  
**Asian Citrus Psyllid**  
*Diaphorina citri* is an  
insect vector of  
Huanglongbing disease  
of citrus.  
Psyllid feeding damage  
includes twisting and  
burned tips of new flush.

Not known to occur in  
California **Huanglongbing**  
or **citrus greening disease**  
is caused by a bacterium.  
Symptoms of the disease  
include leaf mottling,  
yellow shoots, twig  
dieback and small hard  
fruit with a bitter taste.  
The disease is spread by  
the psyllid or by grafting  
infected budwood.
